Establishment of Chapelry - 1969

Priests supplied by Diocese of St. Hyacinthe - 1969 to 1977

Father Auguste Lincourt (approximately 1 year), Father Wilfrid Miclette (approximately 3 Years), Father Charles St. Jean (approximately 2 years), Father George Lemieux (approximately 2 years.

September 8, 1976

A meeting of the Wardens of the Chapelry and Bishop Sanschagrín to discuss the future of Our Lady of Fatima Chapelry. The Bishop gave the Wardens "a free hand" to contact other Diocese or organizations for priests and services, in English, which he was unable to supply for us.

November 2, 1976

The Wardens met with Father Murray Belair, Father Bob Chase and Sister Frances Gallagher at the Center of Spirituality in Montreal. The purpose of this meeting was to seek any help they could offer us in English. The outcome was that they would provide an English speaking priest once a month for our Sunday Mass, beginning the middle of November.

March 7, 1977

A second meeting of the Wardens with Bishop Sanschagrín to bring him up to date in the quest of an English speaking priest. The Wardens will keep the Bishop informed with any progress or new developments as they occur.

July 13, 1977

Father Peter Brown S.S.E. approved as our first English speaking Ministering Cleric, by the Diocese of St. Hyacinthe.

July 1978

Father Peter Morris, approved as Ministering Cleric by the Diocese of St. Hyacinthe.

Summer 1979

Father Ron Fernandes and various other priests served the Chapelry.

Fall 1979

Father Auguste Lincourt re-appointed Ministering Cleric by Diocese of St. Hyacinthe.

January 1980

Father Lincourt too ill to continue as Ministering Cleric.

February 18, 1980

The Wardens met with Bishop Langevin to explain an offer of assist-

March 1980

Father David Cray S.S.E. appointed Ministering Cleric by the Diocese of St. Jean.

November 1980

Letters received explaining that the Chapelry was under the jurisdiction of St. Jean Diocese with the exception of Confirmations and Marriages which will remain with the Diocese of St. Hyacinthe.
